RESOLUTION NO. 182-92

ADOPTING LOCAL LAW NO. 4 FOR 1992 AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 2 FOR THE YEAR 1956

WHEREAS, Local Law No. 2 of 1956 enumerated the Rules and Regulations for the administration of the St. Lawrence County Self-Insurance Plan and the Rules did not include the St. Lawrence County Solid Waste Disposal Authority as a participant, and

WHEREAS, the St. Lawrence County Legislature is currently in the process of having state legislation enacted to have the Solid Waste Disposal Authority terminated to be replaced by a county Department of Solid Waste, and

WHEREAS, since such legislation will not be enacted by January 1, 1993 and the County is desirous of having the Authority changeover its Workers' Compensation coverage effective as of that date, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held by the St. Lawrence County Board of Legislators on the local law,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the St. Lawrence County Board of Legislators hereby adopts Local Law No. 4 for the Year 1992.

LOCAL LAW NO. 4 FOR THE YEAR 1992 AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 2 FOR THE YEAR 1956

BE IT ENACTED by the St. Lawrence County Legislature as follows:

- Section 1. Local Law No. 2 of 1956 is hereby amended by adding to Section 1,A the name of the St. Lawrence County Solid Waste Disposal Authority.
- Section 2. Local Law No. 2 of 1956 is further amended by adding to Section I,B the following paragraph: "The St. Lawrence County Solid Waste Disposal Authority must fulfill the following conditions prior to being admitted to the Plan:

September 14, 1992

- 1) An accurate roster and current medical examination report must be provided to the St. Lawrence County Workers' Compensation Self-Insurance Plan by the Authority for all current & future members.
- 2) The Authority shall provide its last three years accident and injury experience to the St. Lawrence County Workers' Compensation Self Insurance Plan prior to December 1, 1992.

RESOLUTION NO. 183-92

ADOPTING LOCAL LAW NO. 5 FOR 1992 A LOCAL LAW REAPPORTIONING ST. LAWRENCE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS

WHEREAS, the County legislature must adjust its legislative representation in light of the results of the 1990 decennial census, pursuant to the United States Constitution and Article 2 §10 of the New York State General Municipal Law: and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Legislators, after considering the alternatives, has determined that a plan of apportionment consisting of twenty-two legislative districts will best serve the interests of the residents of this county; and

WHEREAS, segments of certain existing legislative district boundaries follow local election district boundaries that do not conform to State law, and therefore require adjustment concurrently with any new plan of apportionment, and

WHEREAS, the St. Lawrence County Board of Legislators has held a public bearing on proposed Local Law No. 5 for the Year 1992,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the St. Lawrence County Board of Legislators hereby adopts Local Law No. 5 for the Year 1992.
