LOCAL LAW NO. 1 FOR THE YEAR 1986

ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE COUNTY HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT

Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the County of St. Lawrence as follows:

Section 1. That commencing with the first County payroll for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six, the annual salary, which does not include earned longevity increments, of the County Highway Superintendent is hereby authorized to be increased from the annual salary for the year nineteen hundred eighty-five to the increased salary of \$36,637.00.

Section 2. Payment of the authorized increase from the annual salary of the year nineteen hundred eighty-five to the increased annual salary herein set forth for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six shall be paid in the County payroll following the date this local law becomes effective, forty-five (45) days after the date of its adoption, and its being duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the state of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the state of New York. However, payment of the increase in salary shall be retroactive to the first County payroll for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six.

Section 3. This local law shall take effect forty-five (45) days after the date of its adoption and on the date it is duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the state of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the state of New York.

LOCAL LAW NO. 2 FOR THE YEAR 1986

ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE DATA PROCESSING DIRECTOR

Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the County of St. Lawrence as follows:

Section 1. That commencing with the first County payroll for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six, the annual salary, which does not include earned longevity increments, of the Data Processing Director is hereby authorized to be increased from the annual salary for the year nineteen hundred eighty-five to the increased salary of \$36,000.00.

Section 2. Payment of the authorized increase from the annual salary of the year nineteen hundred eighty-five to the increased annual salary herein set forth for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six shall be paid in the County payroll following the date this local law becomes effective, forty-five (45) days after the date of its adoption, and its being duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the state of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the state of New York. However, payment of the increase in salary shall be retroactive to the first County payroll for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six.

Section 3. This local law shall take effect forty-five (45) days after the date of its adoption and on the date it is duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the state of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the state of New York.

LOCAL LAW NO. 3 FOR THE YEAR 1986 ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DIRECTOR

Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the County of St. Lawrence as follows:

Section 1: That commencing with the first County payroll for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six, the annual salary, which does not include earned longevity increments, of the Economic Development Director is hereby authorized to be increased from the annual salary for the year nineteen hundred eighty-five to the increased salary of \$29,774.00.

Section 2. Payment of the authorized increase from the annual salary of the year nineteen hundred eighty-five to the increased annual salary herein set forth for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six shall be paid in the County payroll following the date this local law becomes effective, forty-five (45) days after the date of its adoption, and its being duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the state of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the state of New York. However, payment of the increase in salary shall be retroactive to the first County payroll for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six.

Section 3. This local law shall take effect forty-five (45) days after the date of its adoption and on the date it is duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the state of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the state of New York.

LOCAL LAW NO. 4 FOR THE YEAR 1986

ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE COUNTY TREASURER

Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the County of St. Lawrence as follows:

Section 1. That commencing with the first County payroll for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six, the annual salary, which does not include earned longevity increments, of the County Treasurer is hereby authorized to be increased from the annual salary for the year nineteen hundred eighty-five to the increased salary of \$29,453.00.

Section 2. Payment of the authorized increase from the annual salary of the year nineteen hundred eighty-five to the increased annual salary herein set forth for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six shall be paid in the County payroll following the date this local law becomes effective, forty-five (45) days after the date of its adoption, and its being duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the state of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the state of New York. However, payment of the increase in salary shall be retroactive to the first County payroll for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six.

Section 3. This local law shall take effect forty-five (45) days after the date of its adoption and on the date it is duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the state of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the state of New York.

LOCAL LAW NO. 5 FOR THE YEAR 1986

ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE PERSONNEL OFFICER

Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the County of St. Lawrence as follows:

Section 1. That commencing with the first County payroll for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six, the annual salary, which does not include earned longevity increments, of the Personnel Officer is hereby authorized to be increased from the annual salary for the year nineteen hundred eighty-five to the increased salary of \$28,096.00.

Section 2. Payment of the authorized increase from the annual salary of the year nineteen hundred eighty-five to the increased annual salary herein set forth for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six shall be paid in the County payroll following the date this local law becomes effective, forty-five (45) days after the date of its adoption, and its being duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the state of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the state of New York. However, payment of the increase in salary shall be retroactive to the first County payroll for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six.

Section 3. This local law shall take effect forty-five (45) days after the date of its adoption and on the date it is duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the state of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the state of New York.

LOCAL LAW NO. 6 FOR THE YEAR 1986

ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE ELECTION COMMISSIONERS

Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the County of St. Lawrence as follows:

Section 1. That commencing with the first County payroll for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six, the annual salary, which does not include earned longevity increments, of the Election Commissioners is hereby authorized to be increased from the annual salary for the year nineteen hundred eighty-five to the increased salary of \$19,176.00.

Section 2. Payment of the authorized increase from the annual salary of the year nineteen hundred eighty-five to the increased annual salary herein set forth for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six shall be paid in the County payroll following the date this local law becomes effective, forty-five (45) days after the date of its adoption, and its being duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the state of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the state of New York. However, payment of the increase in salary shall be retroactive to the first County payroll for the year nineteen hundred eighty-six.

Section 3. This local law shall take effect forty-five $\overline{(45)}$ days after the date of its adoption and on the date it is duly filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the state of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the state of New York.
