WHEREAS, a public hearing has been held on July 8, 1985, regarding Local Law No. 9 for the year 1985, and

WHEREAS, prior notification of such local law was provided to the members of the St. Lawrence County Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Local Law No. 9 for the year 1985 is here by adopted.

ST. LAWRENCE COUNTY

LOCAL LAW NO. 9 FOR THE YEAR 1985

A LOCAL LAW ADOPTING THE RETIREMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM

Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the County of St. Lawrence, New York, as follows:

- Section 1. The County of St. Lawrence hereby elects to provide all its eligible employees with a retirement incentive program authorized by Chapter 665, Laws of 1984.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The commencement date of the retirement incentive program shall be August 1, 1985.
- Section 3. The open period, during which eligible employees may retire and receive the additional retirement benefit, shall be 90 days in length.
- Section 4. The actuarial present value of the additional retirement benefits payable pursuant to the provisions of this local law shall be funded over a five year period. The amount of the annual payment in each of the five years shall be determined by the Actuary of the New York State Employees' Retirement System, and it shall be paid by the St. Lawrence County Treasurer for each employee who receives the retirement benefit payable under this local law.
- Section 5. This local law shall take effect immediately.

Mr. Burns made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 173-85, seconded by Mr. LaBaff, and carried unanimously by a roll call vote as shown below:
