#### LOCAL LAW NO. 23 FOR THE YEAR 1985

# REGULATING THE DISPOSAL OF MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE IN ST. LAWRENCE COUNTY

Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the County of St. Lawrence as follows:

- Section 1. Pursuant to Sections two thousand, forty-eight-e and two thousand, forty-eight-s of the Public Authority Law, the St. Lawrence County Legislature hereby adopts a local law regulating the disposal of solid waste in St. Lawrence County.
- Section 2. Words used in this law have the meanings given them in Section two thousand, forty-eight-b of the Public Authority Law.
- Section 3. Commencing January 1, 1987, all solid waste generated or originated within St. Lawrence County shall be delivered to solid waste management facilities within St. Lawrence County which are designated by the St. Lawrence County Solid Waste Disposal Authority from time to time.
- <u>Section 4.</u> The Authority may make such exceptions to the requirements of the foregoing Section 3 as it from time to time may determine to be in the public interest.
- <u>Section 5.</u> Persons who or municipalities which deliver or cause to be delivered solid waste to facilities designated by the Authority shall pay charges as fixed by the Authority.
