LOCAL LAW WO. 12 FOR THE YEAR 1984

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL SALARY FOR THE ST. LAWRENCE COUNTY CLERK

Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the County of St. Lawrence as follows:

- Section 1. The annual salary for the St. Lawrence County Clerk shall be \$27,500 for the year 1985.
- Section 2. This Local Law shall take effect 45 days following its adoption by resolution of the St. Lawrence County Board of Legislators.
- Section 3. This salary shall be paid in equal installments beginning on the effective date of this Local Law through the remainder of the year 1985.
- Section 4. The annual salary for the St. Lawrence County Clerk beginning January 1, 1986, shall be \$28,500.
- Section 5. The annual salary for the St. Lawrence County Clerk beginning January 1, 1987, shall be \$29,500.
