**LOCAL LAW NO. 10 FOR THE YEAR 1980
A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE
ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT**

Be it enacted by the Board of Legislators of the County of St. Lawrence as follows:

Section 1. The annual salary for the Administrative Assistant shall be \$29,500.00.

RESOLUTION NO. 102--80

DISPOSITION OF TAX ACQUIRED PROPERTY
