A local law setting the annual salary for the office of commissioner of jurors.

Became a law February 18, 1973 with the approval of the chairman, no petition protesting. Passed by the local legislative body of the county of St. Lawrence. Filed in the office of the secretary of state February 23, 1973.

Be it enacted by the board of supervisors of the county of St. Lawrence as follows:
