## COUNTY OF ST. LAWRENCE

LOCAL LAW No. 1

A local law fixing the salaries of county officers.

Became a law December 27, 1970 with the approval of the chairman, no petition protesting. Passed by the local legislative body of the county of St. Lawrence. Filed in the office of

the secretary of state January 8, 1971. Be it enacted by the board of supervisors of the county of St.

Lawrence as follows:

Section 1. The annual salary for the office of commissioner of elections shall be seven thousand, five hundred dollars. The annual salary for the office of commissioner of social services shall be twenty thousand dollars.
