What is the impact on your department if this position is not filled? Please provide, in detail, the need to fill the position. Please include the service provided, if it is mandated, number of people (clients) affected, and what you will do if the position is not filled.

The Social Services Department, which is normally staffed with four full time attorneys, struggles to cover court appearances and keep up with the legal work. In 2018, the Department prepared approximately 3,430 child welfare documents including petitions and reports for Family Court proceedings. The Department prepared 4.133 such documents for filing in 2019. The Department also prepares hundreds of child support and paternity petitions each year. In addition to children being at risk because of untimely court proceedings, the impact of not having a sufficient number of attorneys includes a diminished ability to adequately represent the Department in child abuse and neglect proceedings, child support and paternity proceedings, adult protective proceedings, and various other proceedings from initial appearances to trials. Department attorneys address a variety of legal issues and are responsible for preparing petitions, motions, discovery replies, appellate briefs, and other documents for filing with the courts, and for fair hearings and appeals associated with child protective proceedings. The Department is under strict time restraints for filing petitions and for occasional emergency court appearances. The Department normally is responsible for appearing in at least two courts. as well as participating in settlement conferences, and some conferences with a court attorney-referee for matters of custody and visitation. This position generates significant reimbursement at approximately 81%.

This position, which is reimbursed at approximately 81%, is needed to make sure that essential accounting work for the Department is completed. The person in this position reconciles monthly expense ledgers, prepares monthly federal and State administrative claiming reimbursement for the Department; reconciles monthly revenue ledgers using the Claims Register; reviews, analyzes and prepares entries for Settlement Notices which include various state and federal revenues and recharges; prepares monthly journal entries to record federal and State revenue; prepares federal and State administrative claiming reimbursement for the Department's current year projected budget figures and next year's budget figures; assists the Fiscal Manager in the budget preparation of both appropriations and revenues; tracks allocations to ensure spending is on target for requested reimbursement; oversees the operation of the Department's cash management system which includes accounts receivables, cash receipts, and trust accounts; assists clients with billing and account inquiries; prepares income executions, and provides unit backup for payroll function. This position affects the benefits and services of more than 20,000 County residents. If this position were not filled, workers in other positions would attempt to carry out this work while sacrificing other necessary work.
