Deed Information Sheet

The following documents are required when submitting a deed for recording:

1. Deed (Required for all Deeds)

- a. These forms can be attained through small business supply stores or by contacting an attorney's office.
- b. Document must be legible and at least size 10 font.
- c. This document must be dated.
- d. Signatures must be original.
- e. Addresses for all parties must be listed on the first page.
- f. Grantor(s) must sign before a notary. Notarial acknowledgement must be complete and meet NYS guidelines for recording. Notary stamps must be legible, contain location of commission and expiration date.
- g. Record & Return must be on the document. Also, include a self-addressed stamped envelope so that we may return the original document.

2. TP-584 (Required for all Deeds)

3. RP-5217 (Required for all Deeds)

- a. This document must be completed electronically and printed on legal size paper. It can be found through our website <https://www.stlawco.gov> or at <https://www.tax.ny.gov/pit/property/new-homebuyers/filing-rp5217.htm>

4. IT-2663 (Required if the Grantor is a Non-NYS Resident)
