St Lawrence County Joint Fire and EMS Advisory Board Meeting

Meeting called to order by Mark Deavers, Chair of St. Lawrence County EMS Advisory Board

Regular agenda items deferred to jointly review a St. Lawrence County Draft Plan

Jonathan Mitchell reviewed the highlights of the plan that included many data points that reflect an increasing stressed EMS system.

There was a concern over the shift in staffing the plan would create

There were some great ideas that were brought up to address the ongoing concerns surrounding EMS education, requirements, staffing, while others were simply offended.

1. Education

- a. EMS Academy
 - i. Not a solution for volunteer providers
- b. Recruit and allow other health care workers to challenge out of certain portions of EMT class (Lab techs, ER techs, etc.)
- c. EMT program in BOCES
- d. More education offered (free)
- 2. Increased Tax incentives for volunteers
 - a. Fire department leaders stated that LOSAP programs were ineffective
- 3. County to contract with agencies to cover calls
- 4. Incentives to departments who meet certain criteria
- 5. Education to public on when to call an ambulance
- 6. Add more BLS into the plan
- 7. Increased communications with dispatch when an ambulance can turn around and take a low priority call versus toning for mutual aid.

Initial call to time on scene was requested as a data point.
