St Lawrence County EMS Mutual Aid Plan



Updated and Approved by the St Lawrence County EMS Advisory Board on 05/27/2025

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Introduction

According to New York State Public Health Law Article 30, "The furnishing of medical assistance in an emergency is a matter of vital concern affecting the public health, safety, and welfare. Prehospital emergency care, the provision of prompt and effective care and transportation of the sick and injured are essential public health services." Achieving this goal can only be accomplished by creating a patient-driven mutual aid plan, designed to put the patient as top priority without regard to agency bias in the event the agency having primary jurisdiction requires assistance. Every EMS agency has an ethical obligation to assure that the patient always comes first.

Given this obligation, a patient-driven unbiased mutual aid plan must be established to provide the necessary apparatus or appropriately trained personnel when and where needed. IT is important to understand that this mutual aid plan will never replace the judgment of dispatchers and EMS providers in the field to make other choices based on the unique needs of an actual incident.

Administration

The St. Lawrence County EMS Mutual Aid Plan shall be administered by the St. Lawrence County Office of Emergency Services Director, St. Lawrence County Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board, and St. Lawrence County EMS Coordinator (If appointed). In addition, the legal authority for this document comes from several sections of the law, including: Public Health Law-Article 30 Section 3001(20), County Law Article 5 Section 223-B, Executive Law Article 2B, General Municipal Law Section 209b (3-a), and various New York State Bureau of EMS Policy Statements.

Annual Review

Each year, this plan shall be reviewed by the St. Lawrence County Office of Emergency Services Director, St. Lawrence County Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board, and the St. Lawrence County EMS Coordinator (If appointed).

Amendments

Amendments to this plan may be made periodically, and shall follow the following procedure:

- a. Amendment prepared by/presented to the St. Lawrence County Office of Emergency Services Director or St. Lawrence County EMS Coordinator (If appointed).
- b. Presented by the St. Lawrence County Office of Emergency Services Director or St. Lawrence County EMS Coordinator (If appointed) to the following:
 - a. St. Lawrence County Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board

- b. Emergency Medical Service agency in which the change affects
- c. Once reviewed and approved by all parties involved and by the St. Lawrence County Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board, the change shall go into effect once approved by motion at a St. Lawrence County Emergency Medical Services Advisory Board meeting.

Participation

Any EMS agency in St. Lawrence County may participate in the EMS Mutual Aid Plan by approving the contents of this plan and by submitting a completed version of the attached resolution to the St. Lawrence County Office of Emergency Services Bureau of EMS Office. Such resolution shall be filed by the St. Lawrence County Office of Emergency Services Bureau of EMS Office.

If an EMS agency wishes to withdraw from participation in this plan, an authorized representative for the agency must submit, in writing, a statement of intention to the St. Lawrence County Office of Emergency Services Bureau of EMS within thirty (30) days of the desired date of withdrawal. The EMS agency shall be required to file their own plan in accordance with New York State Department of Health Title 10, New York State Codes, Rules and Regulations, Part 800.21 (p. 1-6).

Emergency Medical Services Dispatch Procedure

Emergency Medical Services agencies will be activated by the St. Lawrence County Office of Emergency Services Bureau of Emergency Communications Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) located in Canton, NY. In the event this PSAP is inoperable, agencies will be activated from the backup PSAP located in Massena, NY.

St. Lawrence County Office of Emergency Services Bureau of Emergency Communications dispatchers are trained and certified in accordance with the standards International Academies of Emergency Dispatch (IAED) to the Emergency Medical Dispatch level to provide appropriate telephonic care and determine the level of response required by field units (BLS/ALS).

Once the appropriate information is obtained and the call is classified via nature and acuity, the call shall be dispatched by the dispatcher to the agency having primary jurisdiction with pertinent information given. Time of call shall be considered "Minute 0". The following chart shall be utilized to determine subsequent paging durations in the event a full ambulance crew fails to acknowledge via radio or telephone:

BLS Determination If the patient is deemed stable by the dispatcher in accordance with EMD protocol:

0 Minutes Initial Dispatch 4 Minutes Second Page 8 Minutes Third Page & Mutual Aid

ALS Determination If the patient is deemed to be having a lifethreatening emergency in accordance with EMD protocol:

0 Minutes	Initial Dispatch
4 Minutes	Second Page & Mutual Aid
8 Minutes	Third Page

^{**}In exigent circumstances, the dispatcher may enact shorter paging durations, or dispatch mutual aid more quickly.

Justification shall be made on the CAD card**

If the emergency will clearly overwhelm the resources of the individual agency having jurisdiction, the dispatcher may dispatch additional agencies at any interval to backup and support the agency having jurisdiction.

Selection of Mutual Aid

Mutual aid shall be selected by the St. Lawrence County Office of Emergency Services Bureau of Emergency Communications dispatcher by using the following criteria to assist in their selection:

- 1. Proximity of an agency's ambulance or ambulance station/headquarters to the location of the call
- 2. Availability/current staffing status of an agency's ambulance or ambulance station/headquarters

Service type (volunteer, fire, hospital, or commercial) will not be a consideration by the dispatcher when selecting an agency to respond to the request for mutual aid.

Countywide EMS All-Call

In the event four or more agencies are activated and are unable to respond to a singular call for service, the St. Lawrence County Office of Emergency Services Bureau of Emergency Communications dispatcher shall activate the "Countywide EMS All-Call", requesting any available St. Lawrence County ambulance respond. If this occurs, nearby first-responder agencies not having jurisdiction may also be activated to assist in the evaluation and treatment of a patient until an ambulance is able to arrive.

Cancellation of Responding Mutual Aid

Mutual aid may only be canceled when one of the following occurs:

- 1. A request to cancel the ambulance is received from an EMS provider on scene
- 2. It is determined that the patient is no longer at the scene

3. An ambulance checks enroute to the call, and is in closer proximity to the call than the mutual aid being canceled

County EMS Coordinators


To assist both transporting and first responder agencies, St. Lawrence County may elect to appoint an EMS Coordinator in accordance with Section 223-B New York State County Law, specifying: "It is his or her duty to administer the county programs for EMS training and mutual aid in cases of emergencies in which the service of EMS providers would be used; to act as a liaison officer between the county government and the county EMS advisory board and the EMS providers in the county and the officers and governing boards or bodies thereof; and to perform such other duties as prescribed."

On a routine basis, the role of the County EMS Coordinator and Deputy Coordinator(s) shall be advisory. The County EMS Coordinator or Deputy Coordinator(s) shall be automatically notified of any circumstance listed below. Response will depend on the potential benefit to the EMS providers and agencies at the scene, or if requested by the Incident Commander.

- Any reported or confirmed incident involving five (5) or more patients
- Any event in which four (4) or more different transporting ambulance services are paged to respond to a singular call for service
- Any fire or EMS line of duty death or serious illness/injury
- Any EMS vehicle/ambulance accident with injuries
- When requested by any EMS, Fire, Police, or Governmental Unit
- At the discretion of dispatch

It will not be the purpose of the County EMS Coordinator or Deputy Coordinator(s) to assume command, but to work in conjunction with the incident commander to assist in the coordination and acquisition of resources and/or mutual aid. The County EMS Coordinator or Deputy Coordinator(s) may also assist with incident management, hospital notifications, radio communications, or any other tasks as ordered. The County EMS Coordinator or Deputy Coordinator(s) may be relieved/stood down at any time by the Incident Commander or EMS Commander on scene.
