#### **EPT MEANS THAT...**

- After an STI diagnosis, a health care provider can give you treatment medication to give to your partner.
- Your partner gets treated quickly without having to go to the doctor or get an exam.
- You are protected from being reinfected by your partner.

### BUT WHY SHOULD MY PARTNER BE TREATED?

- Your partner may have the STI and not know it because they show no signs.
- Without treatment, you could be reinfected with the STI by your partner.
- STIs can cause serious health problems
