APPROVED "SHARPS"
DISPOSAL CONTAINER
(THESE ARE AVAILABLE AT
YOUR LOCAL PHARMACY FOR
AS LITTLE AS \$3.00 AND
HOLD APPROXIMATELY 100
NEEDLES) AND THEN INTO
YOUR TRASH. NOTIFY YOUR

HAULER THAT "SHARPS"
ARE IN YOUR TRASH. IF
YOU USE A TRANSFER
STATION, NOTIFY THE
SCALE OPERATOR.
